

POLICY:	PUBLIC ACCESS TO PARKS AND RESERVES
DATE ADOPTED BY COUNCIL:	14 NOVEMBER 1995

That Council adopt the following policy regarding public access to Council Parks and Reserves.

- 1. Hobsons Bay City Council makes available to residents all Council owned or controlled parks and reserves for usage other than at those times that have been agreed by Council with sporting bodies, events co-ordinators or other organisations.***
- 2. Where Council owned or controlled parks and reserves or facilities placed thereon may be provided on a restrictive basis by way of lease, licence, or other agreement the periods of restriction are to be agreed in advance.***
- 3. Apart from pre-arranged periods of restriction, those organisations that have such use are to allow access to public areas to persons who may not be members of those organisations.***
- 4. Those organisations are to adhere to anti-discriminatory legislation and Council's policies.***
